The Royal Photographic Society in partnership with The Photographic Angle is offering two 1-year bursaries to support a photographic project that will promote environmental awareness. The bursaries will provide £3000 to assist with travel expenses, photographic equipment and other project-related costs detailed in the application. There are two awards available for applicants aged 16-25 and 26+ years.

The Application

Applications are invited from anyone living or studying in the United Kingdom with an interest in documentary photography and the environmental concerns that we face today.

Applicants are asked to provide:

A portfolio of 6 images from a focused project that you have done in the past. This can be on any topic and should come with a description of the project and accompanied by an A4 sheet with thumbnails of the photographs.

A description of the project you would like to complete supported by the bursary. This should include where you will go, what you will photograph and the importance of sharing this story. We would also like you to include outcomes showing as how you plan to disseminate your project e.g. exhibitions, website, book etc.

75% of the bursary will be paid to the successful applicant at the beginning of the project. The remainder will be paid two months before the end of the project on the completion of a progress report, which should include images and outcomes to date or planned. All applicants should have a UK bank account.

We will notify all applicants on the 15th June 2012 if their application has been successful.
